Brief Description of Issue and Advice provided:-

Noise Nuisance - attached is the 'Bothered by Noise' Leaflet and a reminder that if you can hear the noise outside your property it is too loud! This is **anti-social behaviour** so please respect your neighbour's right to peace and quiet. Persistent noise will be dealt with in conjunction with **Environmental Health** or, if applicable, with your **Housing Association** or Private Landlord. Your neighbours have been issued with the key contact numbers to

The 1990 Environmental Protection Act contains provision for Local Authorities to take action against any nuisance that conflicts with a neighbour's right to the quiet enjoyment of their home

Whilst we might have some sympathy for the difficulties we face with parking we do not excuse situations that are illegal or very inconsiderate to your

YOUR VEHICLE IS PARKED

Wholly on Pathways – preventing access for pedestrians / wheelchair users / buggy users / people with visual impairments	
Across a driveway or dropped kerb	
Too close to a Junction or Bend (less than 10m)	
On the grass verge - probably damaging services just under the surface	
Preventing access for Emergency Vehicles - require a 3m gap	
A Commercial Vehicle that is overweight and cannot park overnight in residential areas	
Part on Pathway - less than 1m gap – restricting access for pedestrians / wheelchair users / buggy users / people with visual impairments	



This is a polite request - please think more carefully where you
